ADULT EDUCATION LEARNING (AEL) LAB - KILLEEN:

The AEL Lab is a self-paced computer lab that provides assistance to prepare for the GED/HiSET test and TASP/TSI college entrance exam. Staff also can assist customers with improving basic math and literacy skills.

CAREER CENTER:

The Career Center is a resource and technology center offering services to assist individuals in finding employment. Services include resume support, career exploration, labor market information and job search assistance. Individuals are required to register in our automated system, which can be done by going to www.WorkInTexas.com.

CENTRAL TEXAS BUSINESS RESOURCE CENTER (BRC) - KILLEEN:

The BRC provides quality business counseling, training and assistance to potential and existing small business owners. Offering entrepreneur learning programs, information, and resources for starting or growing a business.

CHILD CARE SERVICES (CCS):

CCS provides financial assistance for childcare to individuals who are currently working or attending an approved training activity. Customers must meet income guidelines.

CHOICES:

The CHOICES staff provides individuals receiving Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) the start needed for a better life with case management and supportive services while participants work or look for work.

EXPERIENCE WORKS:

The Experience Works program assists individuals 55 years of age or older, who meet certain income guidelines. Participants work part-time for a qualified government or non-profit agency to receive training, supervision and work experience.

SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM EMPLOYMENT & TRAINING (SNAP E&T):

Individuals receiving SNAP benefits, between the ages of 18 and 50, and *without* dependent children may be outreached to participate in the SNAP E&T program. While pursuing employment, SNAP E&T staff provides case management and supportive services.

VETERAN SERVICES:

Veteran services are offered to men and women who have served their country on active duty for at least 180 days and that have a significant barrier to employment. Veteran staff provides case management and job counseling services as well as referrals to potential employers. If interested in speaking with a Veteran counselor, check with workforce staff to see if you meet eligibility requirements.

VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION - KILLEEN:

The Vocational Rehabilitation program helps people with disabilities prepare for, find or retain employment and helps youth and students prepare for post-secondary opportunities. The program also helps businesses and employers recruit, retain and accommodate employees with disabilities.

WORKFORCE INNOVATION AND OPPORTUNITY ACT (WIOA):

WIOA is an employment and training program available to qualified applicants. The goal of WIOA is for participants to acquire the skills necessary to re-enter employment with increased earning capacity or to prepare for career advancement. Various vocational training programs are sponsored at Temple College, Central Texas College, Texas A&M University - Central Texas and more.
