



Rules for the Children's Waiting Room

We reserve the right to refuse any child's admittance for any reason.

Normal hours of operation: Monday thru Friday **8am to 11:30 and 1pm to 4:15pm.**

Children must be between the ages of 3 years and 10 years and must be fully potty trained and in underwear – **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

1. You are responsible for your child while they wait in the Children's Waiting Room.
2. Children can wait in the Children's Waiting Room for a **maximum of 2 hours.** We ask that you check on them if you have not completed your business in this time allotment.
3. You must have business and remain in the Workforce Center.
4. **Food and drink are not allowed** and will not be served.
5. Children are **not allowed to bring items from home** into the Children's Waiting Room.
6. Your child must be appropriately dressed to wait in the Children's Waiting Room.
7. You must present a valid picture ID when checking your child into the Children's Waiting Room. **Your child will not be released to anyone other than yourself.**
8. Children must appear to be healthy and no medication will be administered while in the Children's Waiting Room.
9. Any child left longer than the allotted amount of time **will be considered abandoned** and the proper authorities will be alerted.
10. At any time you can be asked to remove your child from the Children's Waiting Room.
